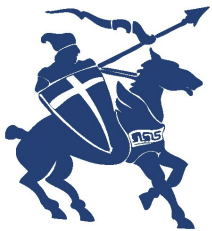

## ► School Supplies

### Grammar

#### K4

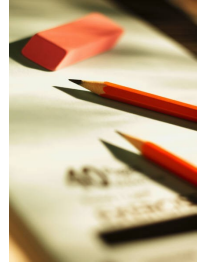

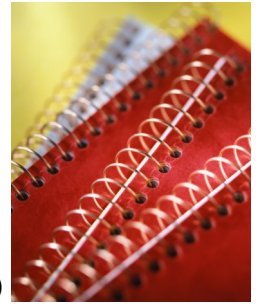
